



## OEA Leaderboard Policy – 2022 Season

The OEA maintains two separate leaderboards for Regular Divisions, and U25 Divisions:

1. Regular Divisions include:
  - Junior (18 and under)
  - Senior (over 18)
  - Open
2. U25 Divisions include
  - 21 and under
  - 22 to 25

### Policy

OEA Membership	OEA membership is required for all riders who wish to accumulate points on the leaderboards. U25 Riders are required to purchase OEA membership and U25 membership to qualify for the U25 leaderboard.
	Points awarded only for EC sanctioned shows which take place in Ontario.

Points	Points to be awarded based on <u>placing in horse show division</u> , even if division is blended with Juniors/Seniors/U25s and/or Open and/or non OEA members. Points are doubled for Intermediate and Advanced placings (see table below)
FEI Placings	Double points to be awarded for riders who place in FEI Divisions for the corresponding EC level: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1* - Modified/EV1.05</li> <li>• 2* - Preliminary</li> <li>• 3* - Intermediate</li> <li>• 4* - Advanced</li> </ul>
Combined Divisions	At the option of the Organizing Committee and to help provide a step between levels, combined divisions may be offered at Horse Trials. These divisions will have the Dressage and Jumping tests at one level higher than the Cross-Country test. Points for placings in combined divisions (e.g. Training/Prelim) will be attributed to the lower level (e.g. Training) consistent with the level of the cross country test (as per EC regulation D301.3)
